Minimum Entrance Requirements

- A minimum of an undergraduate degree (NQF level 7) or an appropriate Advanced Diploma with a major in Business Management, having achieved a grade point average (GPA) of 65% and/or above in Business Management or related subjects undertaken in the final year (exit level) of study. OR
- Applicants who do not meet the above requirements should provide a portfolio of evidence demonstrating formal, informal, and non-formal knowledge, training, work experience, and/or learning in a cognate field of study equivalent to an NQF level 7 qualification to support admission into the programme on the basis of Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).
